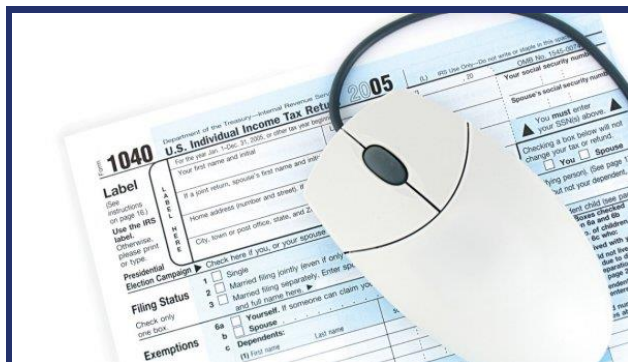

Are you looking for an affordable transportation service that is available when you need it, any day – any time?

For residents of Daly City, Colma, Brisbane, South San Francisco, San Bruno, Millbrae, Burlingame, Hillsborough, Half Moon Bay, Montara, Moss Beach and El Granada —

70 Years and Older

Registration for the limited-membership program will be on an annual basis and may be done on-line or by mail.

As a participant you will be issued a pre-loaded Got Wheels! Membership card and will be able to schedule rides on-demand 24 hours a day/7 days a week. Each month participants are able to take up to 6 one-way trips or 3 round trips for only \$5.00 per one-way ride. Destinations must be within the Daly City, Colma, Brisbane, South San Francisco, San Bruno, Millbrae, Burlingame, Hillsborough, Half Moon Bay, Montara, Moss Beach, and El Granada. Rides must begin and end within the geographic area and San Francisco International Airport

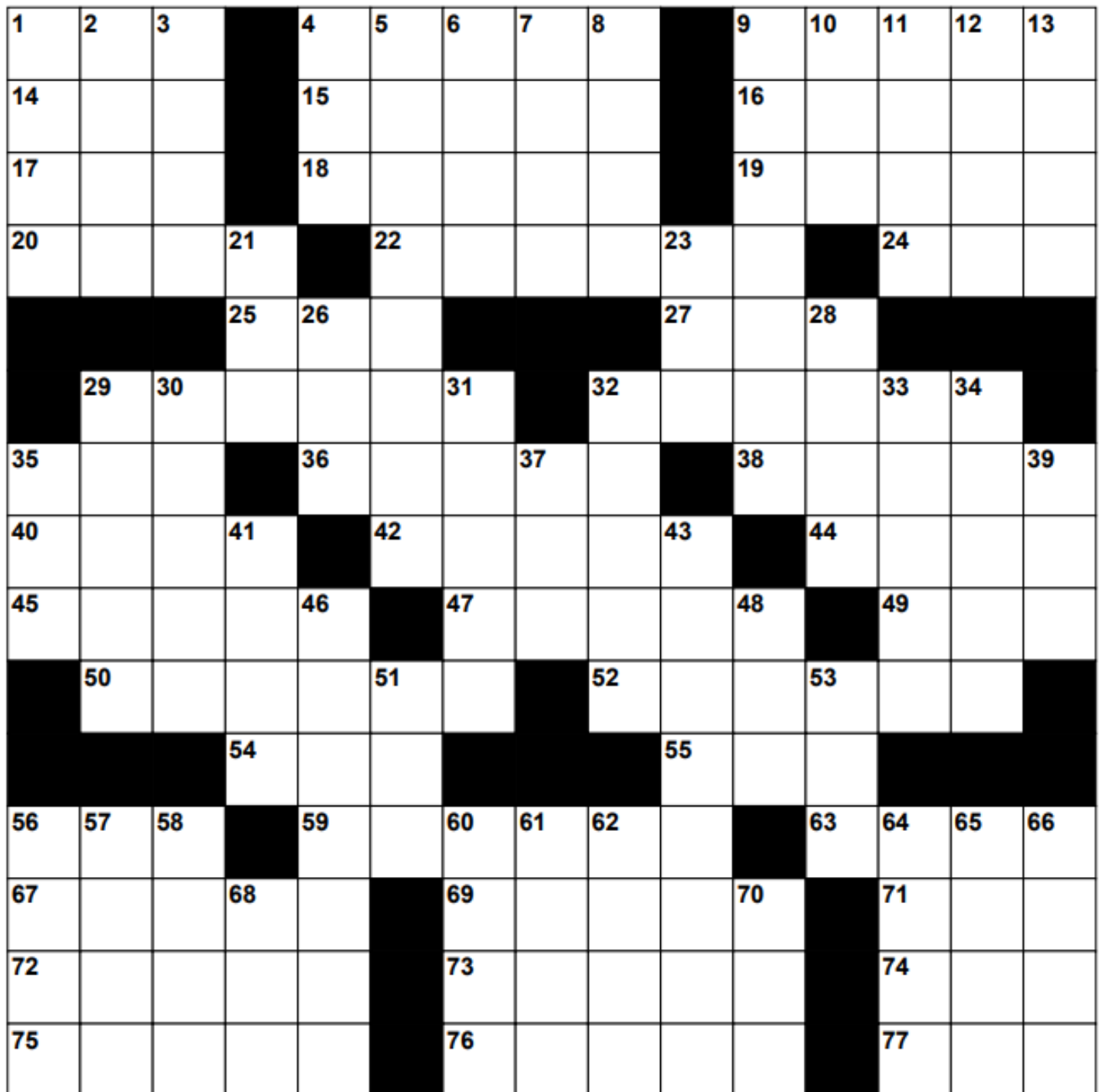

### 2 Scam signs



#### > INSISTENCE

You must wire money immediately



#### > SECRETS

You are warned not to tell others



#### > UNPROFESSIONAL

You notice misspellings and poor grammar

### 3 What to do



#### > USE CAUTION

Only send money to people you know



#### > COMMUNICATE

Reach out and talk about it with others



#### > BE VIGILANT

When in doubt, hang up the phone

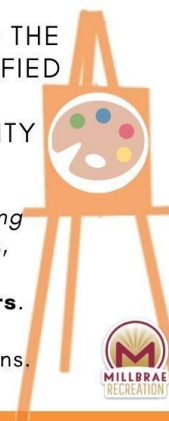
