## "Bags to Benches" A project to Celebrate!



On February 23, 2021, Millbrae Leos Club introduced the "Plastic Bags to Park Benches" Recycling Program sponsored by Trex to the Millbrae City Council. Trex sponsors local recycling programs in communities throughout the country. When more than 500

pounds of plastic refuse in a six-month span (about 40,500 plastic bags), is collected, a high-performance composite bench is donated to the community. Along with the Millbrae Leos Club and Spring Valley Girl Scout Troops, the Leos sponsored: the Millbrae Lions Club, Millbrae Scout Troop #355, Planet Savers of the Peninsula, Millbrae Anti-racist Coalition, and the Bay Area Leo's Club.

Since the project was launched, over 3,500 pounds of plastic refuse has been collected at City Hall from various volunteers across the Millbrae Community. The Leos, Spring Valley Girl Scout Troops, and other volunteers picked up plastic from City Hall and delivered it to Safeway, where a distribution channel had already been established by Trex. Safeway agreed to receive sorted/weighted plastic at their loading dock to add to the shipment to Trex. Through this program, seven benches have been earned for the City of Millbrae.

To honor the commitment to their community through volunteerism, the eight-member Millbrae Leos Board of classes 2021 and 2022 have been awarded the Gold Presidential Volunteer Service Award by the Honorable Joseph R. Biden, President of the United States. The board included President Brian Wen, Vice-President Mark Soliman, Secretary Brandon Hoang, Budget Director Kylie Chan, Membership Director Collin Tse, Project Director Cayenne Wong, Webmaster David Lock, and Historian Austin Wong.

To commemorate this program's dedication and hard work, we will be holding a bench dedication on August 21st at Josephine Waugh Soroptimist Park at 11:00 AM. The bench will be dedicated to the Millbrae Leos Board classes of 2021 and 2022.

What used to be the Office Depot now has plans to transform into a multipurpose building structure. Much care and attention to detail went into designing the new building that will be home to 278 multi-family dwelling units and 17,210 square feet of ground floor commercial space. The project will include 26 units designated for occupancy by Very Low-Income households. A total of 349 off-street parking spaces will be provided for retail and residential uses. ## August is Back-to-School Safety Month

After the long summer days, August marks the time of year when children return to their structured schedules and head back to school for the year.

Central County Fire Department (CCFD) would like to remind everyone to safely share the roads with school buses, pedestrians, and bicyclists and provide children with the necessary knowledge to stay safe when heading to school and after.

### Children should know to:

- Always cross the street with an adult if under 10 years old.
- Use crosswalks, cross at street corners, and obey traffic signals when crossing streets.
- Never run into streets or cross in between parked cars.
- Exit a school bus and cross the street in front of the bus where the driver can see them.

### Drivers should remember to:

- Slow down and be alert in residential neighborhoods and school zones.
- Take extra time to look for children at intersections, curbs and between cars.
- Watch for children on and near the road before and after school hours.
- Reduce any distractions inside your car by turning down music and putting away your phone to avoid talking or texting while driving.

CCFD hopes that with these tips in mind, the start of the school year is safe and stress-free. We hope that students study hard and stay safe, and we wish them the best of luck as they return to school.

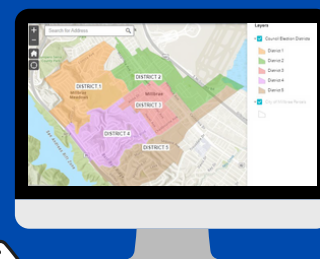
