Welcome to Millbrae Eikon Therapeutics!



The City of Millbrae is excited to welcome Eikon Therapeutics new headquarters to the City! Eikon Therapeutics Inc. is a California-based biotechnology company that applies advanced engineering and high-performance computing to the identification of important new medicines.

In June, Eikon announced the execution of a long-term lease with Alexandria Real Estate Equities Inc. for its new corporate headquarters in Millbrae, on the new life science campus being developed by Alexandria. Construction has already begun on the new campus. Once complete, the campus will be made up of four structures that together include approximately 657, 000 square feet of laboratory and office space, and an additional 16,000 square feet of amenity center. The project is on track to be completed in 2024.

City Manager, Tom Williams stated, "Eikon Therapeutics captures the best of the Bay Area's culture of mission-driven innovation, and we are proud that they have chosen to make Millbrae home to their new headquarters. It is an exciting time of future-looking development in our city, and we look forward to welcoming the entire Eikon team to our community."



AB 1826 - California's Mandatory Organics Recycling Law for Commercial Businesses and Multi-Family Complexes

Does your business or multi-family complex with five (5) or more units generate two (2) cubic yards or more of solid waste (garbage, organics and recyclables) a week? Then you are required to have organic waste collected for compost under state law AB 1826! Non-compliant entities will soon receive a second notice letter to voluntary cooperate and tell the City how they will comply with this law.

My business/multi-family complex has been noticed, what do I need to do to comply with AB 1826?

Your compliance pathway is one of these three options:

1. Subscribe to the organics collection service. You should contact South San Francisco Scavenger Company, by calling 650.589.4020 or emailing info@ssfscavenger.com
2. Send us proof of organic waste self-haul requirements
3. Send us a waiver request for organic waste collection

Here are some tips to protect you and your families during this upcoming holiday season.

- Install a sturdy deadbolt lock on every door leading to the outside.
- Install motion-sensing floodlights in the front and back of your home that are on timers.
- If you will be out of town, work with your neighbors and friends to create a “lived-in look” while you are away. Some examples might include, having someone mow your lawn, pick up your mail, have your mail stopped, do not leave unattended mail in your mailbox and have a car in the driveway.



SHOPPING SAFETY TIPS:

- Shop during daylight hours whenever possible. If you have to shop at night, ask a friend or family to go with you.
- Dress casually and comfortably.
- Don't wear any expensive jewelry.
- Try to avoid carrying large amounts of cash and pay with your cards.

CERT OBSERVES COUNTYWIDE URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE DRILL

On October 25, CERT volunteers from Burlingame, Hillsborough and Millbrae were invited to observe a countywide Urban Search and Rescue drill located in a building on Burlingame's bayfront that is scheduled for demolition.

During the exercise, firefighters from the Central County Fire Department (CCFD), as well as San Bruno, South San Francisco, Menlo Park, Woodside and the San Mateo Consolidated Fire Department, rescued two injured “victims” by punching a hole in an outside wall, then jackhammering an opening in a concrete floor. CCFD Chief Bruce Barron, Deputy Chief Ken Giacotto and Community Risk and Resiliency Specialist Dena Gunning explained what was going on.



While the drill was in progress, everyone's phones lit up with an alert that a 5.1 magnitude earthquake had occurred near San Jose.




