

## Millbrae Expands Homeless Engagement Local Program with LifeMoves Now Called H.E.L.P

On December 13, 2022, Millbrae was awarded \$370,572 by the County of San Mateo Board of Supervisors to continue and expand the existing program with LifeMoves that focuses on the unsheltered population in the downtown area and the BART/SFO transportation corridor. The program aims to link unhoused individuals with shelter services, transportation assistance, and referrals.

In 2021 the City of Millbrae partnered with San Mateo County and the local non-profit LifeMoves, which provided two social workers to conduct homeless outreach at Millbrae BART Station during evening and night-time hours. The pilot program exceeded the original goals and has been able to contact and offer resources and/or services to 432 unhoused individuals since 2021 through the end of the pilot program, which ended on December 31, 2022.

The City of Millbrae applied for the Working Together to End Homelessness (WTEH) Innovation Grant from the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors to obtain funding to continue the great work and success of the pilot program with LifeMoves. The City was awarded the grant on December 13, 2022. The approved grant authorizes an allocation of American Rescue Plan Act funds ("ARPA Funds") under the WTEH Grant Program to fund the continuance and expansion of the City's original LifeMoves pilot program under the new program name of Millbrae Homeless Engagement Local Program ("H.E.L.P."). The expansion of this program provides services now for both the BART/SFO transportation corridor and the Millbrae Downtown area through June of 2024.

The purpose and goal of H.E.L.P. is that through our partnership with LifeMoves we will be able to provide

On March 31, 2023, The San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Motor Unit worked a 4-hour detail focusing on safe driving conditions.


During that short window of time, they issued over 80 citations for speeding, failure to obey posted signs, distracted driving, and other various violations.


