Leash Laws & Animal Control Information


There's a leash law in the City of Millbrae!

When out in public, your dog needs to be leashed and under your control unless you're in a designated off-leash dog park. The City currently has one dog park at the new Gateway at Millbrae Station, available for public use during daylight hours.

We welcome dogs to utilize all our parks, but pursuant to law, they must remain on a leash continuously held by a person capable of controlling the dog. Please use our free dog bags throughout our parks to pick up your dog's feces and help keep our parks clean for everyone!

The City of Millbrae contracts

with the County of San Mateo which utilizes the Peninsula Humane Society & SPCA (PHS), a private non-profit organization, to enforce all animal control laws, shelter homeless animals, and provide various other services. Please call Peninsula Humane Society at (650) 340-8200 for any concerns regarding dogs off-leash or other animal-related issues. Translation Services Being Tested

The City of Millbrae is now testing translation services through Wordly. Wordly translation software enables meeting attendees to read live captions or listen to audio translated into over 30 languages. Participants can use their own computer or mobile device. No human interpreters or special equipment is required. Wordly is currently developing the software to implement Cantonese as an offered language by the end of summer.

If a language is not offered that an attendee requests assistance for, such as Cantonese, or the attendee requires special assistance or a disability-related modification, we ask that you contact Elaine Tran, City Clerk forty-eight (48) hours in advance by calling (650) 259-2414. Notification prior to the meeting will enable the City to make reasonable arrangements to ensure accessibility to this meeting.
