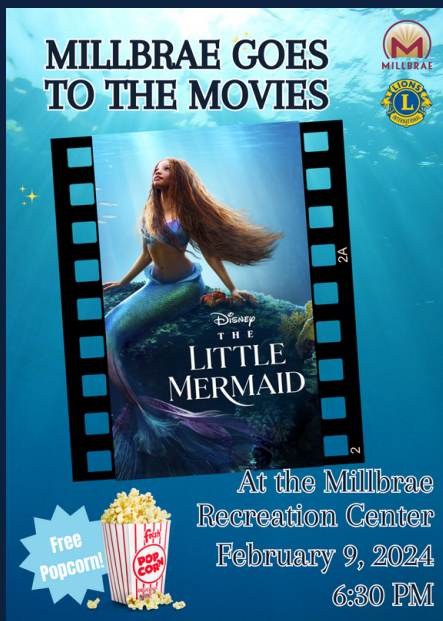

**MILLBRAE GOES
TO THE MOVIES

Alexandria Center for Life Sciences



The Alexandria Center for Life Sciences (ACLS) is Millbrae's largest active construction project. The 4.7-acre life sciences campus will ultimately consist of four buildings totaling approximately 570,000 square feet, containing laboratories and office space for an estimated 2,055 professionals working in the biotechnology industry. Once completed, the primary tenant will be Eikon Therapeutics, a biopharmaceutical company that focuses on discovering treatments for diseases through proprietary technology that includes microscopes able to observe and track real-time, molecular-resolution measurements of protein movement in living cells.

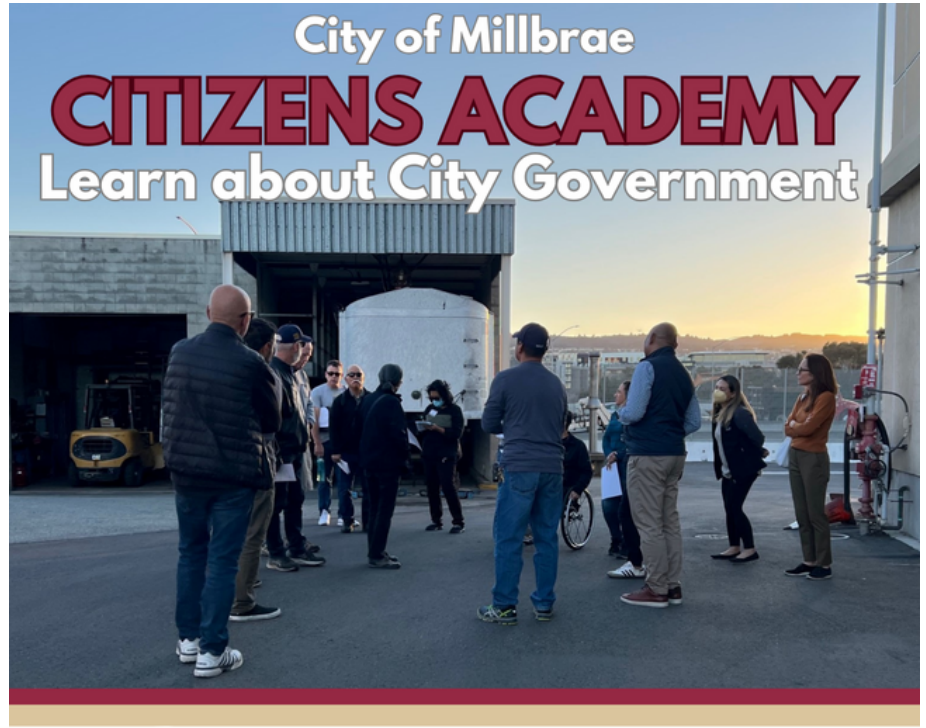
The largest building under construction, building 3, located at 230 Harriet Tubman Way, completed steel framing with a topping out ceremony held on May 18, 2023. The most visible activity on the job site is the roofing system and exterior wall glass panels currently being installed. The amenities building located at 6 Rollins Road is also under construction. These two portions of the overall project are expected to be completed by spring of 2025. The remaining portions of the campus, including the parking structure and laboratory buildings located at 201, 231 Adrian Road, and 30 Rollins Road, will be constructed in a second phase expected to begin no later than 2028. The development is currently installing underground utilities and a storm drainage system at those locations, to be followed by the construction of temporary parking lots for tenants' use during the interim first phase of development.

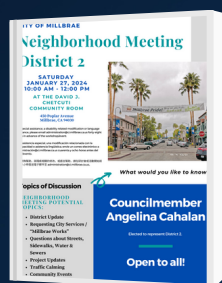

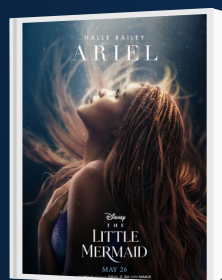
