

COUNCILMEMBER ANGELINA CAHALAN'S ANSWER TO RECALL STATEMENT  
(Pursuant to Elections Code§ 11023)

In 2022, Millbrae transitioned to district elections. I was inspired to run for office in our neighborhood that experienced neglect for decades. I wanted our neighbors to have a seat at the table. I won the election by an 11.9% margin.

With every issue and policy that requires my input or vote, I do thorough research and meet with City staff to ensure that I make educated and thoughtful decisions. I bring a different perspective and pose questions that deepen conversations in the community and Council meetings.

In less than 12 months in office, I brought increased City communications to residents around the Marina Vista and Bayside Manor Park remodels. I knocked on doors to personally invite people to community meetings and to complete city surveys. I worked closely with City staff to ensure SFO followed through with clearing the Lomita Canal to prevent flooding. Residents tell me they appreciate the work I am doing and that I take the time to respond to their questions and concerns.

An expensive recall election will be funded by your tax dollars.

I work hard to make Millbrae better for my family and neighbors. I hope to continue to serve our community.
