Active 101: US 101 San Mateo County Crossings Improvement Plan

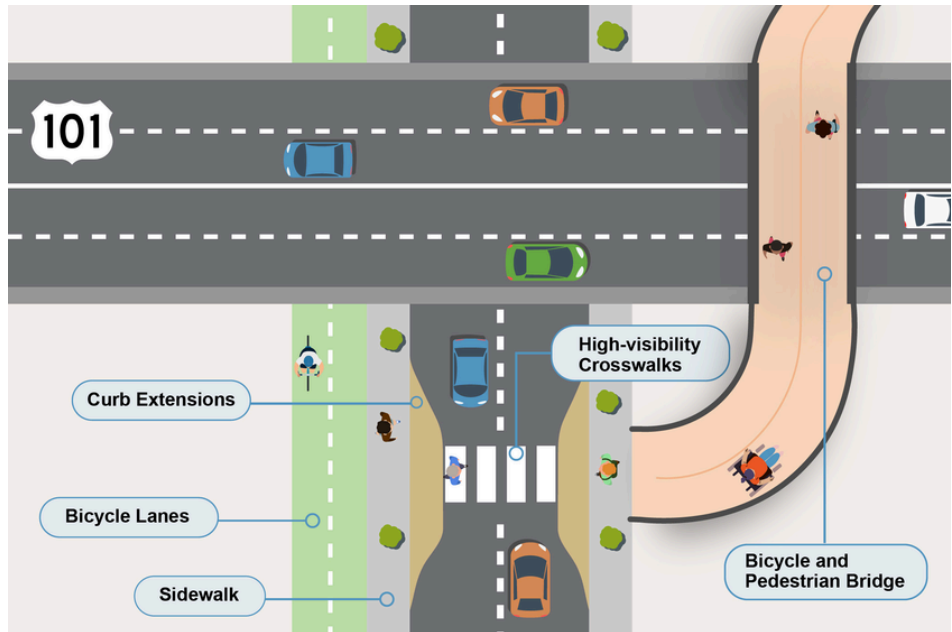

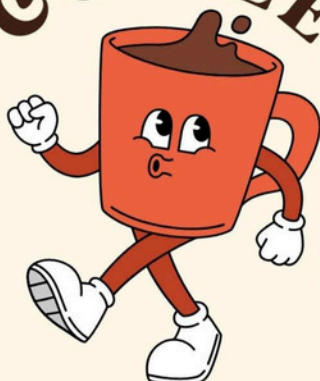
