A NEW SPACE FOR FUN, COMMUNITY, AND RELAXATION

After more than 25 years without updates, Marina Vista Park has been completely revitalized to enhance the quality of life for residents and create a welcoming space for recreation and community connection. The reimagined park offers something for everyone, with exciting new amenities and upgraded infrastructure.


The park now features a shaded picnic area with tables and a grill, perfect for outdoor meals with family and friends. A fenced-in playground includes a slide, climbing net, swings, and even a special swing designed for grandparents to enjoy with their grandchildren. For sports enthusiasts, there are two small basketball courts that double as soccer fields, offering versatile play options. The newly rebuilt lawn is lush and well-maintained, complete with irrigation sprinklers and gopher barriers to ensure a safe and enjoyable space for kids to run and play. Surrounding the park is a serene garden, adorned with Crape Myrtle trees, a variety of plants, and ground cover. This peaceful retreat provides a habitat for bees and butterflies, overlooks the creek and SFO airport, and serves as a tranquil escape from the stresses of daily life.

Additional upgrades include benches, BBQ grills, a drinking fountain, a dog waste station, and a shade structure, all designed to improve comfort and convenience. Infrastructure improvements, such as enhanced water utilities, a storm drain system, bioretention areas, concrete pathways, and erosion control, ensure the park is functional and sustainable for years to come.

Millbrae, you have the right to repair it! Work with others to disassemble your broken stuff: open it, learn how it works, and (hopefully) fix it. Bring your broken, non-functioning things: electronics, appliances, computers, toys, etc., for assessment, disassembly, and possible repair. We'll provide workspace, specialty tools, and guidance to help you disassemble and troubleshoot your device. Whether we get it fixed or not, you'll learn more about how it was put together and how it worked. This is a family-friendly event: children are welcome to join and help fix their items!


