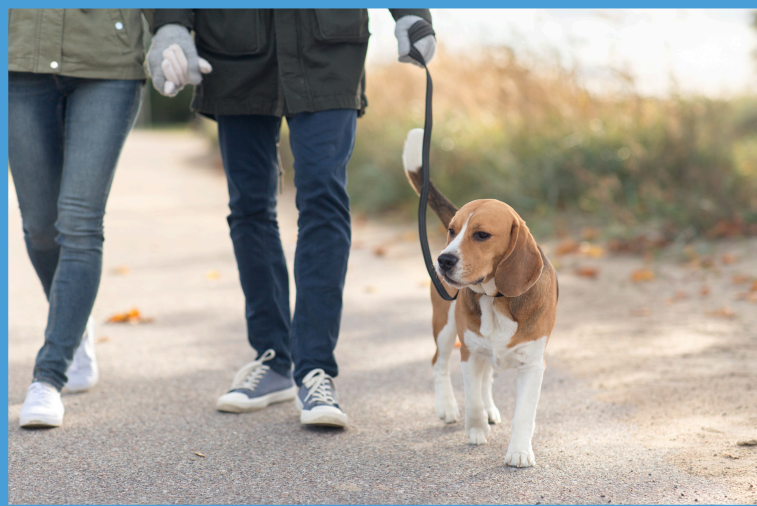


MILLBRAE GREEN BUSINESS INITIATIVE



LEASH LAW IN MILLBRAE

There's a leash law in the City of Millbrae! When out in public, your dog needs to be leashed and under your control. The City currently has one dog park at the Gateway at Millbrae Station on the westside of Rollins road North of Millbrae Avenue, available for public use during daylight hours. We welcome dogs to utilize all our parks, but pursuant to law, they must remain on a leash continuously held by a person capable of controlling the dog.

CALIFORNIA RESIDENTIAL MITIGATION PROGRAM

Starting February 12, 2025, and running through March 26, 2025 eligible homeowners can apply for up to \$3,000 in seismic retrofit grants at EarthquakeBraceBolt.com. Additionally, income-eligible homeowners may also qualify for supplemental grants. Up to \$7000 in additional grant funds are available for households with an annual income at or below \$89,040, which may provide up to 100% of the funds needed to cover a seismic retrofit.

Grants are contingent upon meeting eligibility requirements and available funds. These grants aim to fortify homes against earthquakes, especially those built before 1980 and located in high-hazard areas.

This year 303 new ZIP Codes have been added, making the total number of eligible ZIP Codes 1,118. We wanted to make you aware of this, as well as seek your help in informing your residents.

To illustrate the importance of a retrofit – view the images of two houses below – the home on the left slid off its foundation during the magnitude 6.0 Napa Earthquake, which struck the area on August 24, 2014. The home on the right did not, due to seismic retrofitting.
