Free Shredding Event This Saturday

Paper shredding isn't just about clearing clutter, it's essential protection against identity theft. Old bank statements, medical records, and tax documents contain sensitive information that criminals can exploit if carelessly discarded. Professional shredding ensures these documents are destroyed beyond recovery.

Millbrae residents have a convenient opportunity tomorrow. The city is hosting a free Community Shredding Event on Saturday, December 6, from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM at the Millbrae Library Parking Lot (1 Library Ave).

Bring up to five file boxes of paper documents for secure destruction. To keep things moving efficiently, you won't be able to watch the shredding process, but rest assured your documents will be properly destroyed. Remember: paper only, no binders or metal.

This is an excellent chance to safely dispose of years of accumulated paperwork while protecting yourself from fraud. Don't let sensitive documents become a security risk, take advantage of this free community service.




